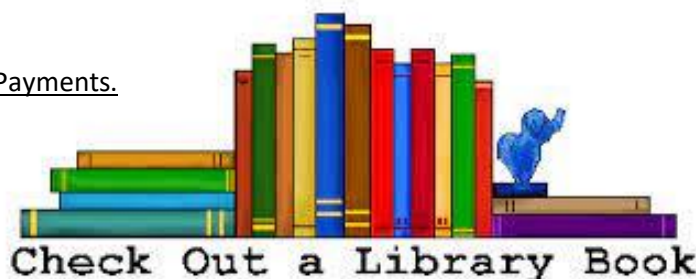
FVRL Summer Reading

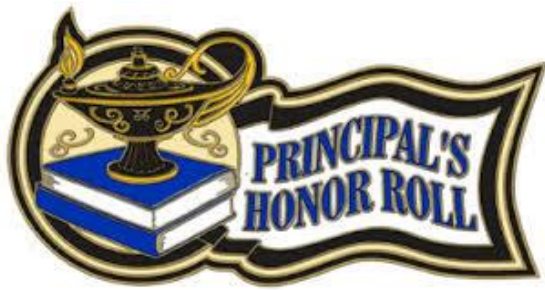
